

ACV DL 72 Denis Pivard, bourgeois de Moudon, notarial register, 1609-1618, inventory and extracts, FHL Microfilm #0922430.

One register, "Premier Registre", cover badly damaged, with répertoire covering fols. 1-193, although the numbered folios extend to 199. Fols. 14-33v are missing, but the titles of the missing transactions are supplied from the répertoire. Also, it appears that fols. 189v-192 were not photographed, but the edges of those pages are visible in the microfilm. Their contents are supplied from the répertoire as well. Additional sheets are inserted after fol. 197v. The microfilm is quite dark, but the writing is clear and generally legible.

1 19 jun 1609, Noble François de Villarzel mayor de Lucens with his mother Susanne de Graffenriedt sells to Jean son of the late François Badoz de Cremin.

1v 16 jul 1609, Michel son of Anthoine Bosson bourgeois de Moudon sells to Judith daughter of the late Bernard Jordan bourgeois de Moudon and wife of Jaques Henri de Villards-le-Comte.

2v 31 aug 1609, Gaspard Jossevel bourgeois de Moudon as tuteur de feu François Jossevel de Bussy sells to Michel Bosson.

3 08 oct 1609, Jean fils de feu Pierre Wagnieres de Boillens demeurant à Romont cedes to Anthoine Bize bourgeois de Moudon, his rights to the succession of his uncle Jaques fils de François Wagnieres and regarding the widow of the late Jean Wagnieres, brother of the said Jaques.

4 19 nov 1609, Elye Dutoit fils de feu Claude Dutoit de Chavannes bourgeois de Moudon sells to Pierre Dutoit son frere tisseran bourgeois de Moudon. (See below, Pierre Dutoit the weaver, son of the late Claude, and brother of Elie, is also called Pierre Dutoit le jeune.)

5 14 dec 1609, Spectable François Monnery ministre à Constantin sells to Philippe Chastellennaz bourgeois de Moudon.

6. 27 dec 1609, Prononciation: Michel, Jaques, et Beneist Bosson freres, fils de feu Anthoine Bosson bourgeois de Moudon, contre Philippe Pache fils de feu Estienne Pache aussi bourgeois de Moudon, with his brother Thomas Pache hors du Pays. The Pache brothers are testamentary heirs of their aunt the late Martine Pache widow of the late Claude Revy vivant meusnier à Moudon, and the Bossons are the testamentary heirs of the late Claude Revi. The testament of Martine Pache was recorded by Pierre Nicaty 02 apr 1607, and the testament of Claude Revi was recorded by the late Jaques Nicaty 02 sep 1589. Claude Revi was the uncle of the Besson brothers.

9 28 mar 1610, Jean Mestreaux cordonnier et bourgeois de Moudon sells to Michel Bosson.

9v 10 may 1610, Jaques Jaquery notaire bourgeois de Moudon sells to Guillaume Frossard hoste et bourgeois de Moudon, with right of reachept perpetuel.

10 05 apr 1610, Mariage: Daniel Demierre fils de feu Humbert Demierre vivant conseiller et bourgeois de Moudon with his brothers Spectable Abraham Demierre ministre à Ouron (=Oron), Jaques, et Isaac Demierre, and François Bel de Lucens, parens et alliez; to Françoise Panchaud fille de feu Egrege Claudi Panchaud vivant bourgeois de Moudon et commissaire, with her mother Evaz Goudar and her brother Egrege Pierre Panchaud and her maternal uncle Jean Goudard bourgeois d'Yverdon and her beau-frère Anthoine Richard notaire bourgeois de Moudon, Noble Spectable David Réal ministre à Pouilliez-le-Grand, Benoist et Jean Panchaud père et fils de Pouilliez, et Egrege Anthoine et Jaques Dutoit notaires et bourgeois de Moudon, parens et alliez. Françoise has a sister Dorothee Panchaud who is the wife of Egrege Anthoine Richard. Marriage contract and quittance for the dowry.

14 30 nov 1610, Assignal: Jean Comtessaz cordonnier habitant à Moudon for his wife Evaz Burchet fille de feu Jean Burchet conseiller et bourgeois de Moudon. The widow of Jean Burchet was the late Jacobe.

15 17 dec 1610, Abandonnation en faveur de la commune de Bussy.

(1), regarding Jacobé's request to obtain a partage with her brother regarding the estate of their father the late Jean Gaschet, there was a prononciation faite cy-devant entre honorée Catherine Maillard mère de ladite Jacobé d'une part, et ledit Noble Josué frère d'autre, par laquelle estoyent ordonnez à laditte Catherine pour toutes pretentions presentes et advenir sur les biens meubles et immeubles delaissez par ledit feu Noble Jehan Gaschet son mary, assavoir tous et singuliers leurs biens meubles et immeubles, betail, et autres choses à eux appartenantes existantes au village de Dompnaloye et lieux circonvoyrans, à condition neantmoins que venant laditte Jacobé sa fille au saint estat de mariage, la jouissance de la moytié desdicts biens luy debvroit appartenir. (2) Au regard de ce que ledit Sieur Josué Gaschet demandoit que sadicte soeur fut tenue de desgraver de la somme de Onze cens quarante six florins vers les Seigneurs de Cheires par lesquelz il en recherche comme bien tenant de deux ouvriers de vigne cy devant soubastez à feu Noble Abraham Degruffiez premier mary d'icelle par Denix Bel de Grandvaux... Expenses appear to have been settled, no further information.

94v 04 jan 1615, Exchange: Abraham Bize conseiller de Moudon sells ? to Pierre Wagnieres officier et bourgeois de Moudon.

95v 04 jan 1615, Abraham Bize leases to Pierre Wagnieres.

96 04 jan 1617, Exchange: Abraham Bize and Jean Frossard l'aisné bourgeois de Moudon demeurant à Bussy.

97 26 feb 1615, Pierre Frossard bourgeois de Moudon sells to Claude Grimmoz bourgeois de Moudon.

97 21 mar 1615, Exchange: Jean Dutoit fils de feu Claude Dutoit and François fils de Louis Bel acting for his wife Louise Frossard.

97v 21 mar 1615, François Bel sells to Abraham Bize conseiller de Moudon.

97v 13 dec 1614, Prononciation: regarding rehemption pretendue par Daniel Poyterlin bourgeois de Moudon cessionayre de François Pictet d'une pose de terre..., the tenementier is Michel Bosson, who obtained the lease on the property in an exchange with the heirs of the late Jean Mestreaux bourgeois de Moudon. Bosson had sold the lease to François Vaulruz bourgeois de Moudon. Estiennaz Bargnoen ? (possibly an attempt at Borgonion ?) whose first husband was Jean Mestreaux held the reachpt on this property, dispute involves Egrege Jaques Dutoit and his brother Gaspard Dutoit. Also debt owed to Wolf Frossard.

99v 27 aug 1615, Jean fils de feu Egrege Daniel Nicod bourgeois de Moudon cedes to Claude et Pierre Dumolin père et fils de Marnant.

100 17 jul 1615, Jaquemaz fille de feu Jaques Dutoit de Chavannes femme d'Egrege Nicod Dufourt notaire de Domp martin cedes to Egrege Anthoine Dutoit et Daniel fils de feu Pierre Dutoit both bourgeois de Moudon, her rights to property at Chavannes inherited from her brother the late Maurice Dutoit. She had inherited a half interest in most of these. The widow of her father is being supported sa vie durant by the heirs.

101 25 sep 1615, François fils de feu François Girard de Denisy sells to Michel Bosson.

101v 25 sep 1615, Exchange: Michel Bosson and François fils de François Girard.

102 25 sep 1615, François fils de François Girard sells to Michel Bosson.

102v 08 oct 1615, Jean Nicod releases ? Nicod Dufourt from his obligation to pay a cense on a property at Lovattens. The obligation was originally that owed by Claude fils de feu Hugonyn Ogguey to Daniel Nicod, in a reconnaissance dated 01 nov 1582, recorded by Egrees Jaques et Pierre Richard, commissaires.

103v 13 nov 1615, Prononciation: Jean Favre, property rights at Thierrens.

(Inserted after fol. 105, additional sheets containing;

23 jul 1615, Settlement of a dispute between Jean and Claude Demierre freres de Montet, dividing their debts.)

106 13 dec 1615, Egrege Jaques Jaquery sells to Gaspard Dutoit marchand bourgeois de Moudon, a reachept.

106v 20 dec 1615, Lettre de cense: Anthoine fils de feu Jaques Dutoit de Chavannes and his wife Marguerite Debestaz, principals, and Gaspard Dutoit, fiancé, debtors, to Sieur Pierre Crousaz, conseiller de Lutry. The text is highly edited and somewhat ambiguous due to numerous insertions and deletions, one of which, apparently inserted and then lined out as irrelevant, says that Gaspard Dutoit is the beaufrère of Pierre Crousaz.

107 10 feb 1616, Vincent Dou Trelegué ? de Vulliens sells to Pierre fils de feu Claude Dutoit bourgeois de Moudon.

107v 12 feb 1616, David Crisinel de Denisiez sells to François fils de feu François Girard, a half interest, the other half is held by Anthoine Girard verrier.

108 21 feb 1616, Jaques Josseval de Bussy sells to Gaspard Dutoit.

109 02 mar 1616, Partage: Anthoine fils de feu Jean Trolliet de Seigneu bourgeois acting for himself and as legatayre de Person Pictet sa feu femme, contre Jaques Trolliet his brother acting for his wife Françoise, sister of the said late Perrisson Pictet.

116 03 mar 1616, Exchange: Gaspard Dutoit and Marie Jossevel femme de Jean Frossard.

117 15 mar 1616, Prononciation: François Bel de Lucens and his wife Louise Frossard, contre Egrege François Bettez secretaire de Lucens. The mother-in-law of Louise was Clemence Franc.

118 25 mar 1616, François Burnand favre et bourgeois de Moudon sells to Jean Burnand le jeune de Vulliens.

(Fols. 120 and 120v are blank.)

121 09 mar 1616, Settlement: Tenants of properties of the late Pierre and the late Claude Grec are held to owe to Jean Nicod annual censuses, because: (1) A partage was recorded by the late Egreges Rod Demont and Rod Baudat, dated 04 apr 1542, in which the three brothers Pierre, Claude, and Anthoine Grec agreed to pay this cense to their brother Jean Grec. (2) This cense was exchanged by the late Jean Grec with the late Claude de Martherenges alias Sabateyroz (elsewhere usually Savataire or Savatayroz), predecesseur maternel dudict Jehan Nicod, reçu Jaques Creaturaz notaire 16 jan 1544. (3) However, the late Jean Grec had sold or exchanged some of the cense, which ended up with the Seigneurs de Denesy (the Cerjat family), but some part of it remains payable to Jean Nicod.

124 30 apr 1616, Settlement: Spectable Pierre Mellier ministre à Montpreveyres contre Noé Fevot ministre à Mexieres acting for his wife Noble Judith Mellier, daughter of the said Spectable Pierre Mellier. Judith had inherited from her “soeur puisnée” (i.e, her younger sister) Claudine. Other contracts and inheritances are involved in the dispute but are not specified, some property was at Payerne, a grandmother is mentioned but not named.

126 08 feb 1616, Dispute between the communes of Corevont and Thierrens.

130v 18 jun 1616, Prononciation: François Gerard and his wife Louise Broye contre Jean Broye de Prevondavaux her brother. Their father was François Broye, and her brother was Pierre Broye.

132 15 jul 1616, Exchange: Philippe Cerjat and Pierre Dutoit bourgeois de Moudon.

133 18 jul 1616, Sulpitius (this name is usually shortened to Sulpy or similar in local records) des Borines bourgeois de Moudon had sold to Bernard Rod de Villard Menraz, a debt involving Pierre Pictet.

134 06 aug 1616, Prononciation: Egrege Abraham Delessert commaissaire et procureur de Noble Pierre de Dortans Seigneur de Borchier (=Berchier) contre Jean Perrin de Rueyres, regarding the estate of his son the late François Perrin. Other siblings are involved.

136v 06 ? sep 1616, debt involving the commune of Thierrens.

138 19 nov 1616, Arrest: Guillaume Frossard contre Gaspard Dutoit, concerning taxes and a wall between their properties.

139 12 jun 1617, Anthoine Dutoit l'ainé bourgeois de Moudon principal and Aymé Dutoit son frère favre, regarding a debt recorded by Egrege Anthoine Dutoit 27 nov 1612, payable to Peterman Gavuens barbier et bourgeois de Moudon.

140 27 apr 1614, concerning the late Spectable Pierre Marceau vivant ministre à Combremont-le-Grand (probably the sone of Estienne Marceau) and Daniel Demont bourgeois de Moudon, over rights to the disme of Le Plan, apparently referring to a preceding document that is now lost, and the proceedings may have been updated 04 apr 1616.

142 16 feb 1617, Exchange: Abraham Bize and Pierre Porchet dict Gagniere de Siens.

143 08 apr 1616, more proceedings, including a copy of the item on fol., 140, concerning the matter of Spectable Pierre Marceau, settlement.

144 01 may 1616, François fils de Pierre Girard de Denisiez sells to François fils de Claude Girard or Gerard.

145 20 aug 1616, Jaques Jaquin bourgeois de Moudon sells to Guillaume Frossard absent, represented by Philippe Callin bourgeois de Moudon.

145v 23 aug 1616, Pierre Rospraz de Lucens sells to Gaspard Dutoit.

146v 02 sep 1616, Philippe Cerjat sells to Jaques Bosson bourgeois de Moudon.

148 26 nov 1616, Discret Philippe Tacheron bourgeois de Moudon sells to Anthoine Martin de Neyreux.

148v 08 jan 1617, Gabriel Brougeois de Curtilles owes cense to Jaques Frossard conseiller de Moudon.

150 17 apr 1616, Jenon fille de feu Jaques fils de feu Claude Dutoit de Chavanes, femme de Pierre Chappuis de Corcelles-le-Jorat, sells to Gaspard Dutoit, her part of the disme of Chavannes that she inherited from her late father.

151 17 apr 1616, Jenon fille de feu Jaques fils de feu Claude Dutoit de Chavannes with her husband Pierre Chappuis sell to Michel Veyre, and on 28 feb 1618, Michel Veyre cedes this asset (“a remis l’acte suscripte”) to Daniel Burnand de Chavannes.

151v 16 feb 1617, Mariage: Anthoine Porchet cordonnier et bourgeois de Moudon, to Susanne fille de François Vauruz bourgeois de Moudon, who has another daughter Antheyne, wife of Pierre Bize.

152v 20 feb 1617, Pierre fils de feu Claude Dutoit sells to Abraham Bize.

155 02 apr 1617, François Borrel et Pierre Myvilaz sell to Jaques Bosson.

156 22 mar 1617, Prononciation: Jaques et Isaac Demiere brothers, acting for their brother Jean, heirs of the late Daniel Demierre their brother, contre Pierre Panchaud acting for his brothers, regarding property of his sister the late Françoise Panchaud who had been the wife of the said late Daniel Demierre.

157 30 jan 1617, Prononciation: Abraham Bize contre Abraham et Pierre Fabry. The widow of the late Egrege Pierre Fabry was Marguerite, and their son is Egrege Abraham Fabry. Marguerite has now died, and the procès of her succession has continued from long ago. The father of Marguerite was the late Egrege Estienne Decrevel.

170v 23 oct 1617, Jean Mestraulx cordonnier et bourgeois de Moudon sells to Daniel Riguet.

171 12 oct 1617, Exchange: Abraham Bize et Jean et Claude Martin de Neyreux.

172 01 aug 1617, Prononciation: Jean Mestraulx bourgeois de Moudon contre Pierre Crousaz banderet de Lustriez, concerning property originally held by the Demierre family, and as of this date by the heirs fo the late Abraham Demierre.

173 03 dec 1617, Settlement of accounts between Jean Faucheres for his bellemère Catherine, contre Pierre Reschoz. George Gillian was the guardian of Catherine. Balthazard Decristaz was the previous guardian of Catherine.

174 17 dec 1617, Pierre Callier de Vulliens is appointed notary, he is the son of the late Egrege Jean Callier, and brother of the late Egrege Jean Callier, son of the said late Jean Callier.

177 19 feb 1616, Accord, Spectable Piere Dutoit, and Daniel Joly acting for his wife who was an heir of the late Egrege Jaques Rospraz de Granges.

179 27 jan 1618, Noble Jean Pierre Polin citoyen de Lausanne contre Jean Plantin de Montpreveyres, debts. Plantin had rented a property to Felix Dutoit who had not maintained it.

184 18 feb 1618, Prononciation: Jean Billiet contre Abraham Billiet (Billiet is an alias of Dutoit). The parties are: Jean fils de feu Rod Dutoit dit Billet assisté aujourd’huy d’honorable Abraham Dutoit son frère et de David Dutoit son frère, contre Jaques fils de feu François Dutoit dict Mailliard assisté d’Egrege Jaques Pidoux son beaufrère.

(The first instance we have discovered of the alias Billet or Billiet in the terriers is in ACV Fn 129 (1592), applied several times to the Rod Duthey son of Jehan who leased property in 1578 (see especially fol. 396v in Fn 129), inherited by his sons Jehan, Abraham, Pauloz, and Nycod. From the terriers, it seems certain that the father of Rod Dutoit dict Billet was Jean, not Nicod.)

195v 06 mar 1618, ratification by these parties, at Payerne.

18 aug 1617 Thomas Soquet bourgeois de Moudon owes Anthoine Dutoit notaire 1,800 florins, secured by various properties at Donnaloye, with their specifications, "des pieces et possessions par luy acquises tant des hoirs de feu Sieur Gaschet que de Jehan Guiguer que furent

des de Gruffiez, de Bernard Besançon, et aultres”, even though the Gaschet are not otherwise mentioned.)

196 03 jun 1617, Prononciation: François Bel bourgeois de Lucens, François Chevaley de Thierrens acting for his wife George Bel, and Pierre Decropet acting for his wife Susanne Bel, all children of the late Bartholomé Bel et de Clemence Franc, who has since married en seconde nocés à Hans Thibaud Decrevel, contre Abraham Decrevel fils desdits Hans Thiebaud Decrevel et Clemence Franc.

- 04 aug 1618, Elizabeth Bergeron wife of Spectable Pierre Fabry contre Jonas Jaquemet, final settlement ?

198 (clearly labeled) No date found, Jaquemaz fille de feu Jaques Dutoit de Chavannes, wife of Nicod Dufourt notaire de Dompmargin, cedes to Egrege Anthoine Dutoit conseiller et Daniel Dutoit, regarding the partage made with the late Mauris Dutoit son frère (i.e., Mauris was the brother of Jaquemaz, see above, fol. 100) fils de feu Jaques Dutoit (whose widow is mentioned but not named). This may be another copy of the same transaction recorded on fol. 100.

199 20 oct 1618, Egrege Jean Macquelin bourgeois de Moudon et de Vevey purchases from Bastiannaz Butty wife of Balthazard Jayet bourgeois de Moudon. She is the widow of the late Jean Wagnierres.

199v No date found, Pierre Rod favre de Rossan acting for Françoise fille de Jean Dupuitz maistre d'escole à Lucens, by consent of Evaz Perron mother of Françoise, now wife of Jean Rospraz, sell to Egrege François Baillif.
